The Grounds Committee has replaced several trees and shrubs, totaling forty planted this spring. Please water these new trees and shrubs, one to two times a week, into the fall. We plan to conduct another tree and shrub evaluation this fall to replace any other dead or damaged plants.

Four of our lawns will be restored in the fall when cooler and wetter conditions arrive. Estimates are completed. This will include adding soil, fertilizing, seeding and aeration.

Many of our pear trees and smaller ornamental trees have fungus diseases caused by the warm and humid night conditions. We are waiting for an evaluation from our tree expert, arborist, concerning these issues.

Estimates are being sought for removal and stump grinding of several of our dead trees.

The severe storm, during the night several weeks ago, split a pear tree at 125 FMD and brought down a huge branch across the street. Thanks to B&R, part was moved to allow one way traffic until the following day when MM&M removed it.

We continue preparations to get Pond #3 dredged, including dump site evaluations and excavation estimates. Pond #2 and #3 fountains were repaired but now #3 is not operational. This replacement will be delayed due to the proposed dredging.

We are seeking volunteers to help water flowers and to research tees, shrubs and flowers that we grow. Contact Jane 724-916-6029, if you might be interested. This project will last into the winter months and is done online.

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Building & Roads Update

2023 Asphalt Activity – Driveway Replacements & Repairs – Reminder: This activity is still expected to begin in late August. Specific instructions will be emailed to affected residents once a firm date has been established.

2023 Asphalt Activity – Seal Coat for the 2022 driveway new asphalt – **Reminder**: This work will be performed on August 30, 2023. Should it rain on the 30th, the 31st is the alternate date. The affected residents will not have access to their driveways for vehicle traffic for 48 hours, including the day of the sealing. Specific instructions will be emailed to these residents in early August.

Sidewalk Crack Repair & Overlay Project – Determine coating material and plan to overlay cracked stoops. We planned to offer residents with cracked stoops an opportunity to have this unsightly condition corrected at your expense, on a voluntary basis. We have had numerous requests for a solution to this cracking.

Last month's Update: In the next couple of days, the affected locations will receive an email with the approximate cost to overlay your stoop for your review and final indication of interest to proceed. We will recap the final locations and determine whether we have a basis to negotiate a better price with the contractor.

Current Update: The following is the recap of replies from candidate locations:

- Phase I 26 locations. 8 said yes or maybe. 7 said no. 11 gave no response. Yes, or maybe = 636.9 square feet or \$4,458.30.
- Locations: Clubhouse, Mail House, 103 FMD, 111 FMD, 137 FMD, 175 GAC, 183 GAC, 228 GAC.
- Phase II 15 locations. 8 said yes or maybe. 7 gave no response. Yes, or maybe = 481.8 square feet or \$3,372.60.
- Locations: 506 FMD, 512 FMD, 517 FMD, 520 FMD, 522 FMD, 540 FMD, 544 FMD, 548 FMD.
- Total Project 16 locations. 1,118.7 square feet. \$7,830.90.
- We are now waiting for the contractor to be available for a site meeting.

2023 Building Inspections - This is the second year of our triannual building inspection process. This year we inspect Buildings 20 thru 33 (40 units). Inspections have now been completed. The Board recently approved \$2,125 for the first installment of painting. The roof repairs have been scheduled. The vinyl siding cleaning and other miscellaneous items will be scheduled shortly.

Paint stop bars, handicap signs, and parking space lines Project – This Project was completed by Casmac Line Striping at a cost of \$1,050.
