## **Grounds Report**

Our Spring projects have begun. Mow, Mulch & More has cut our lawns in April and are now edging and mulching our shrubbery beds.

This May 20<sup>th</sup> will be the Grounds Committee's third meeting this year and we hope to have our Annual Spring Walk Around completed and tabulated. We order replacement shrubbery from Godwin's Nursery and Mow, Mulch & More removes and plants for us. The removed shrubbery will have their space marked with orange tape or spray paint for convenience of planting.

Some of our boxwoods can be revigorated by cutting out the small areas of dead leaves and allowing them to fill in with new growth. Shrubbery will be trimmed only, not dead cut out, and hillsides trimmed in May by Mow, Mulch & More.

As an upgrade, we are in the process of getting quotes for a new fountain for Pond 2. Mow, Mulch & More is now responsible for fountain storage, installation, removal and cleaning.

Contractors are visiting Pond 3 to evaluate excavation costs of sludge removal. Our dump site on FMD- road to the woods- will have the dry sludge removed.

The Tree and Shrubbery List Research continues as we seek more choices for our approved List. We would appreciate new volunteers to help in this endeavor. A trip to Trax's Nursery is planned to find more shrubbery varieties to add to our List.

The Grounds Committee will soon be asking our volunteers to help us plant and water the annual flowers. A watering schedule is being prepared for the annuals in the urns and the inground flowers around the Clubhouse and Entrance area.

## **Building & Roads Report**

**2024 Asphalt Activity** – The Board has approved the 2024 asphalt work which will be provided by Tarbuck Asphalt. This year is the first year that we will be performing a mill & overlay of the topcoat of asphalt on streets. Pine Brook Court and the lower half of Fair Meadow Drive in Phase II were scheduled for this activity in the Reserve for this year. We had the engineering firm who conducted our Reserve Study confirm that this work was needed this year. Further, prior to performing the street work on Pine Brook Court, the engineering firm and our asphalt contractor required that all driveway work be completed on this street prior to the street work. As a result, we will be performing the replacement of all remaining driveways on Pine Brook Court along with the other driveways found during our Spring driveway inspection that will require replacement this year. This driveway work will commence after the middle of May and the street work will commence after the middle of May and the street work will commence after the middle of May and the permitting.

The specific addresses for the driveway work are as follows:

402 Pine Brook Court - Full replacement.

404/406 Pine Brook Court – Full replacement with improvement to drain.

408 Pine Brook Court – Full replacement.

410 Pine Brook Court – Full replacement.

412/414 Pine Brook Court – Balance – Garage Area – 414 PBC.

143/147 Fair Meadow Drive – Balance.

141/145 Fair Meadow Drive – Full Replacement.

119/123/125/127 Fair Meadow Drive - Balance.

305 Mill Creek Lane - Full replacement.

319/321/325 Mill Creek Lane - Balance.

For these locations, please refrain from scheduling contractors to perform work or events which may involve extra vehicle traffic during the May work period. You will receive specific instructions once a firm start date has been obtained from Tarbuck. Once work commences you will receive daily emails on the progress and work scheduled for the next couple of days. Plan on your drive-way not being available to you for the day of the old asphalt & base removal and for 2 days after the topcoat is installed. We need your garage door to be open during all work. Your vehicle(s) will be parked on the street during these times. Please email me at <u>kayrichards50@comcast.net</u> of any scheduling issues you may have. We will try to work around them, if possible.

Thanks everyone for your continued patience, and courtesy to the workers and contractor's vehicles. This asphalt work affects us all in one way or another. We are 60% completed on our Mill Slag Base Driveway Replacement Project which began in 2020. We have also worked on any needed repairs to the stone base driveways during this period.
