One of the primary functions of the Board is financial oversight of the Associations funds even though we have a financial committee, that makes recommendations to the Board, but do require Board approval. This includes the annual budget for regular expenditures. At the annual meeting it was announced that our maintenance fee would move from \$330 to \$345, at the recommendation of the Finance Committee. The reasons for the increase were threefold: electricity, insurance and sewage.

They also oversee the Reserve Fund for Capital Expenditures, which involves replacement and maintenance of capital items which would include roads, buildings, pool and clubhouse..

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RECYCLE

One of the big changes coming in 2025 will be the way recycle. Historically, the Township has always sponsored contracted recycling for our residents, but it has become increasingly cost prohibitive to continue to do that. In 2023, Recycling cost taxpayers over \$180,000. As we strive to provide more efficient, cost effective services, beginning in January, the Township will be self-performing recycling collection. We purchased a recycling truck and have arranged for a recycling vendor to process the materials. This will save residents considerably. To that end, we are going to ask for your patience as our crews begin this collection, learn the routes, etc. Until we can gauge how long collection will take us, we are going to divide the Township in half and collect for half the Township on the second Monday of the month, as always, but delay the other half until Tuesday of that week (i.e. the Tuesday following the second Monday), just to make sure we can get through the Township. As we develop a system and pattern, we expect to become more efficient and will be able to better gauge how long collection will take. So, please be patient if we don't get to you until Tuesday or Wednesday and understand that we may need to adjust as the year goes on so that we may serve you better and more cost effectively.

APPLE DIP

1 8oz block of cream cheese

½ c. sour cream

½ c. powdered sugar

1 tsp, pure vanilla extract

½ c. jarred caramel or dulce de leche, plus more topping for the top

1/4 c. crumbled graham crackers

2 Tbsp. butter melted

2 Tbsp. granulated sugar

½ tsp. kosher salt

Apples thinly sliced for serving

DIRECTIONS 1. In a large bowl using a hand mixer, beat together cream cheese, sour cream, powdered sugar, vanilla and caramel until fluffy. Transfer to a serving bowl.

2. In a small bowl, stir together graham crackers, melted butter, sugar and salt. Sprinkle over cheesecake mixture. Drizzle more caramel sauce on top, if desired, and serve with sliced apples.

Olive Balls

2 C. sharp cheese

1 c. flour

1/2 c. soften butter

Sm. Pimento olives 36 or so: drain well and dry on a paper towel

Form the dough into a ball. Take small pieces make a small ball, and tuck the well drained olives into each piece of dough, roll until the olive is well inside.

Bake at 400 degrees for 15 minutes.
